Enclosed herewith is the application of Thomas W. March to purchase 150,000 feet board measure, saw timber and 75 cords of wood to be cut from matured green timber situated upon the W. 1/2 of the NW 1/4, Sec. 6, T. 2 S., R. 5 E., and N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 2 S., R. 4 E., B. H. M., pennington County, South Dakota and within the limits of the Black Hills Forest Reserve being the same area involved in Public Timber Sale, Case No. 98 and upon which the present applicant is cutting under the above named case. I also enclose sketch map and report of Head Ranger Kent. I made a personal examination of the proposed cutting and also of the condition of the cutting in Case No. 98, on Sunday April 20th. I find that the purchaser is doing excellent work and that there is an immediate and pressing demand for the saw timber involved in this application at the town of Hill City, South Dakota, the business portion of which was entirely destroyed by fire a short time ago. I recommend that this sale be made immediately without advertisement as provided for in the

published notice of sale in Case No. 98. I find that a fair and reasonable price for the material involved to be \$3.00 per thousandfeet board measure for the saw timber and 40¢ per cord for the wood cut from green timber and \$1.00 per thousand board measure and 25¢ per cord for the material cut from dead timber on the tract.

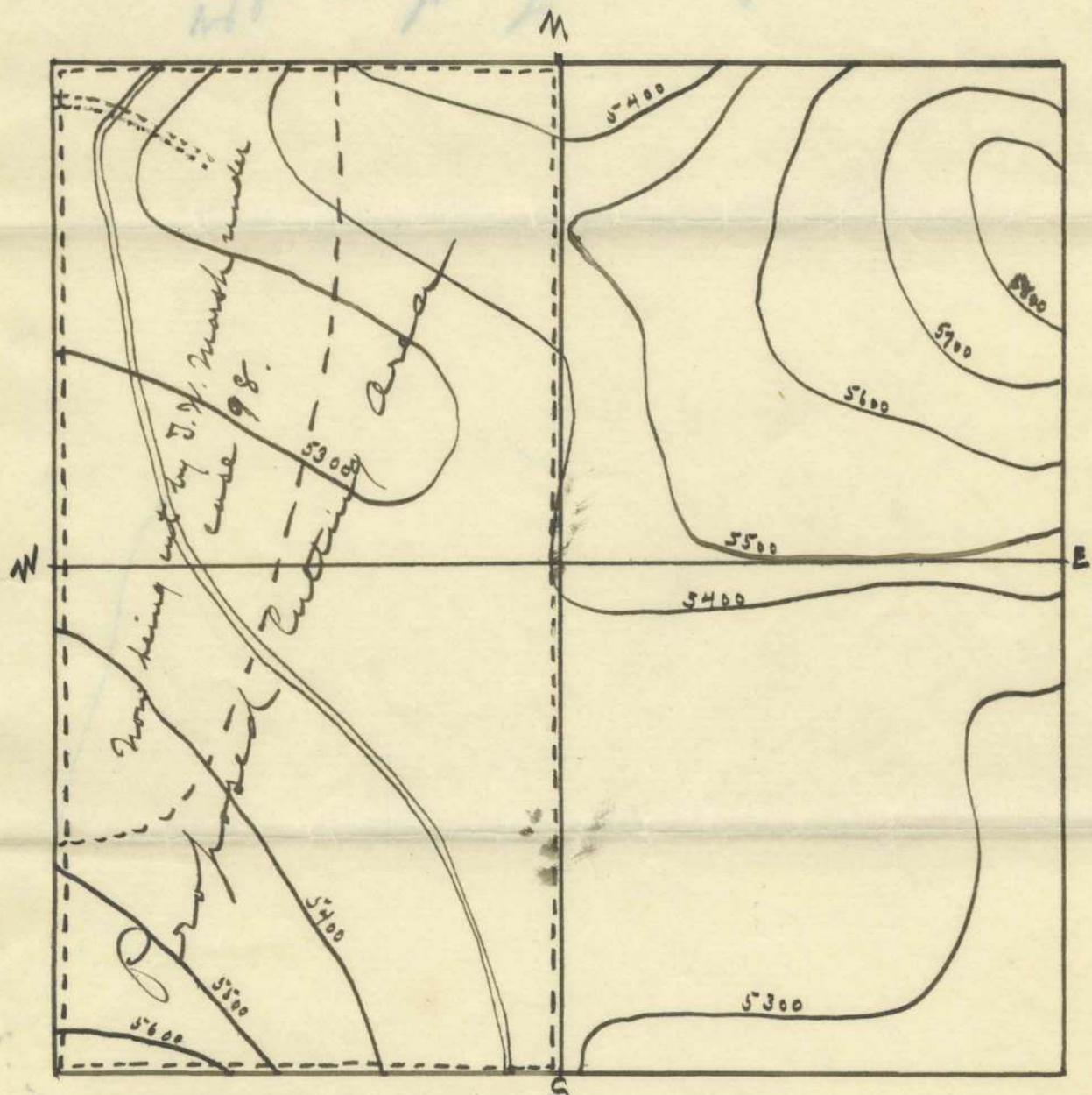
