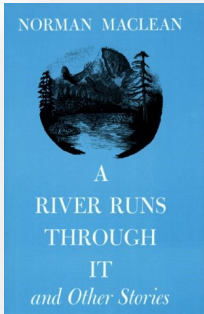

TAPPAN ROCKER: Made especially for the National Museum of Forest Service History

Frame of American elm, accents (arms and slats) of iconic American chestnut. The Chestnut came from a large pollinator in Berlin, Vermont that was a full 3' diameter at its base when it fell to the blight about a decade ago. The Elm was also a large tree that used to be right across the street from Adam's shop--it died and was harvested about 30 years ago.

Adam Nudd-Homeyer, seventh and latest in a now two-hundred-year-old dynasty of stewards, has taken ownership of the title "Tappan Chairmaker" for this current age. Immersing himself in a study of the story and build of these singular chairs, he has returned models into modern production, using historic tools, machinery, and techniques. He has introduced a range of fine, local furniture woods, expanding the selection of the line, and offering to the modern world what this brand has become, both in elegant style and historic story: a line of fine furniture.
